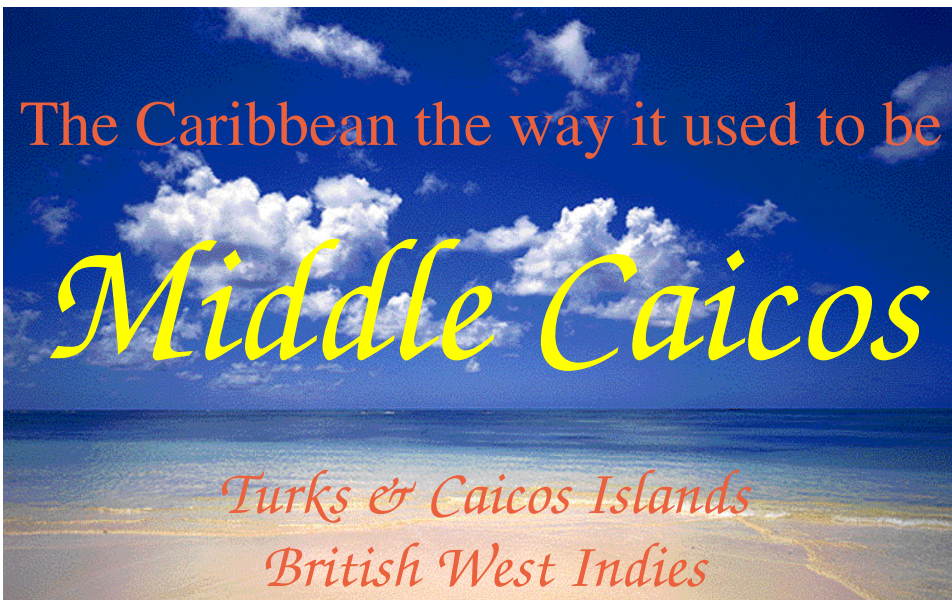

**Blue Horizon Resort offers cottages and villas scattered over the most beautiful beachfront location in the country.**

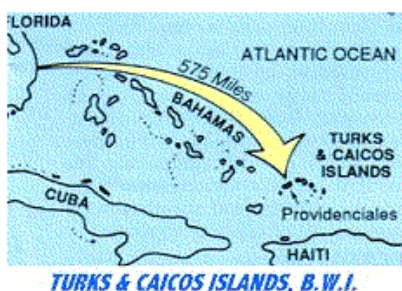
